

**The Shabbat Celebration**



Mark 2:27 Then He said to them, "The Sabbath was made for man, not man for the Sabbath. Blessed are you YHVH ELOHIM, King of the universe, who gave us Shabbat. We bless you Yeshua Who are the Light of the world. May Your light shine through us."

**Out of Egypt I called My Son**

**Shabbat Shalom!** (The blessing or greeting on the Sabbath.) Shabbat is the Hebrew word for Sabbath, and we will use both names. It is a celebration, a delight, a joyful occasion! In essence, Shabbat is a day spent with YHVH, with family, resting and enjoying nature!

Shalom is that wonderful Hebrew blessing meaning: peace, tranquility, safety, protection, well-being, welfare, health, contentment, success, comfort, wholeness and integrity.

Gen.2:1-3 Thus the heavens and the earth were completed in all their vast array. By the seventh day God had finished the work He had been doing; so on the seventh day He rested from all His work. God blessed the seventh day and made it holy, because on it He rested from all the work of creating He had done.

Pesach or Passover is all about the sacrifice of a spotless lamb whose blood covered and protected the Israelites from the judgment of YHVH, when the Angel of Death "passed-over" them.

For nearly four millennia, therefore, the Jewish people have faithfully celebrated each anniversary of their liberation from Egypt with a memorial meal similar to the one their ancestors ate in haste that night when they were preparing for the exodus.

**Lamb:** "Behold the Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world."

For 1500 years the Israelites rehearsed the sacrifice of the Lamb and then covered and protected the Israelites from the judgment of YHVH, when the Angel of Death "passed-over" them.

1 Cor.5:7-8 Get rid of the old yeast that you might be a new batch without yeast - as you really are. For Christ, our Passover Lamb has been sacrificed. Therefore let us keep the Festival, not with old yeast of malice and wickedness, but with bread without yeast, the bread of sincerity and truth.

1 Cor.11:25 A man ought to examine himself before he eats of the bread and drinks of the cup.

Yeshua took it one step further when He explained the ultimate meaning of servanthood, namely humility. Washing His disciple's feet.

**Washing of Hands** the Holy Spirit given on Pentecost To bring in the harvest of souls




